GENERAL INFORMATION

ALENZA Conditioner improves the efficacy of herbicides by conditioning the water before the herbicide is added by modifying the effects of hardness, pH, etc. **ALENZA Conditioner** contains ammoniacal nitrogen, which has been determined to increase the uptake of certain herbicides. **ALENZA Conditioner** also contains chelators, sequestering agents and pH modifiers that aid in guarding herbicides from the effects of water hardness and other problems.

Do not use **ALENZA Conditioner** where the herbicide label warns about its use at low pH or under acidic conditions, or with sulfonyleurea (SU) or DMSA-based herbicides.

Copper and copper compounds such as copper oxychloride, Copper Count N, basic copper or cuprous hydroxide, should not be used with **ALENZA Conditioner**.

Direct contact to this product by workers, by spray, or drift, or direct contact, should be avoided.

The applicator must, either have experience with the use of this product, or conduct a jar test, to determine the compatibility of this product with other tank mix partners.

FIRST AID

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If Swallowed: Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

READ AND FOLLOW DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON HERBICIDE LABELS.

It is recommended to use test areas when applying during high humidity, high temperatures or other possible situations where field practice is restricted.

1. Fill spray tank half full of water and begin agitation.
2. Add desired rate of **ALENZA Conditioner** to water before adding pesticides.
3. Add pesticides, as directed by label, while maintaining agitation.

NOTE: If pesticide label recommends the addition of a surfactant, follow instructions accordingly. **ALENZA Conditioner** is NOT a replacement for a surfactant.

RECOMMENDED USE RATES

Use 2 to 10 ounces per 10 gallons of water as a general use water conditioning agent for pH reduction and hard water sequestering.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container. Keep tightly closed and do not allow other chemicals to be introduced into the container. Do not contaminate water sources by runoff from cleaning of equipment, disposal of equipment washwaters or spray waste.

DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. Decontaminated containers may also be disposed of in a sanitary landfill.
