

INTERSTATE 75 - FLORIDA

Florida Department of Transportation . District 5 State Highway Maintenance

PROJECT OVERVIEW



DBi Services has provided comprehensive performance-based asset maintenance services for FDOT District 5 along Interstate 75, as well as some primary roadways in Marion and Sumter Counties, since March 2014. The project is a seven-year contract that runs through 2021.

This project consists of 218 centerline and 842 lane miles of limited access interstate and state primary roadways. The scope includes inspection and maintenance of over 110 structures, as well as four rest areas and two Weigh-in-Motion Stations (WIMS), and oversight of four Department of Corrections (DoC) work crews.

DBi Services maintains the project rest areas and WIMS through a partnership with RESPECT of Florida, who provide employment opportunities for Floridians with disabilities.

The four DoC works crews perform fence clearing and repair, litter removal, tree trimming, manual slope mowing, guardrail repair, small sign repair, drainage cleaning and repair, landscape maintenance and other similar types of maintenance activities.

Project Highlights

DBi Services responds to incidents and emergencies 24/7/365. We are always prepared in advance knowing that I-75 sees a large influx of travelers during Thanksgiving week and weekend, for both the holiday and the Florida/Florida State Football game. DBi Services schedules our emergency responders to ensure enough in-house staff to respond to any incidents and accidents over the holiday weekend.

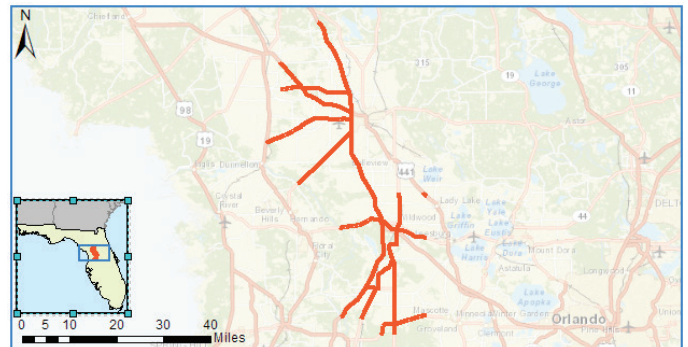
A severe bridge strike on one Thanksgiving Day set DBi Services' emergency response team in motion, which established temporary maintenance of traffic, cleared the scene of debris, performed a bridge inspection and began a two-and-a-half-week reconstruction process that is considered, to date, one of the fastest, well-managed and most thorough bridge repairs performed in the state of Florida.
